
Living by the reign of His Peace! Brought to us by Rev. Ian

As the disciples huddled together behind a closed or even locked door on the evening of the first day of the resurrection, we are told that rather than peace reigning in their hearts, in its place, was fear; 'fear of the Jewish leaders' (John 20: 19). Though they had very strong reasons to believe the impossible had happened, that their adored Leader had risen from the dead, (with huge implications for the world then and now), nonetheless, thoughts of His murder lingered in their minds.
