Message from the Rector - Windrush

We have just celebrated the 75th Anniversary of the Windrush generation arriving at our shores. Certainly this was a good thing to do, but it also reminds us of our nation's guilt with regard to the poor welcome to our land and churches of fellow members of our common wealth, many of whom are our brothers and sisters in Christ. We are also reminded of our negligence, if not incompetence, in wiping out vital records of their arrival, resulting in painful and unjust legal processes which only cover our nation with shame.

For myself my formative childhood and early adult years were spent in Somerset and then Bristol. I was largely not acquainted with different cultures, though I do remember a reference to Enoch Powell's infamous 'river of blood' speech, which of course was focused upon no less than Wolverhampton! I suspect we all agree that was a true example of hate speech.

I want to close by sharing how we should celebrate each other as brothers and sisters in Christ from different nations and races...

First, the words of an esteemed late Zimbabwean Pastor who said simply, in a Christian context, 'white + black is gold'! We could say the same I think wherever there is Christian unity between different cultures and races.

Second are some words from the book of Revelation. 'After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb' all worshiping the Lord. (Revelation 7: 9). I remember vividly arriving in Malawi in the 1990s and being in a worship service where the Malawians were singing in their native tongue. It was as if heaven had come down to earth and was a foretaste of that great gathering before the Throne of God. In Bushbury Parish may we celebrate our ethnic diversity and humbly honour each other from whom we have so much to learn and celebrate, for in our worship before our King we stand together and equal.
